



## BBC Radio International Classical Music Catalogue – Proms 2017

Every summer in London, the world's biggest classical music festival takes place - the BBC Proms. For two months, ensembles, soloists, and conductors from around the world descend on the Royal Albert Hall to make their contribution to the festival's rich musical offering.

2017 season the BBC Proms celebrates various anniversaries:

- The 450th anniversary of Monteverdi's birth is marked with a performance of the composer's choral masterpiece, the Vespers of 1610.
- 500 years after Martin Luther published his *Ninety-Five Theses*, the Proms celebrates the Protestant Reformation with music by J S Bach and Schütz, plus an all-Czech Prom of works inspired by the Bohemian Reformation.
- The Russian Revolution of 1917 is also marked throughout the season with performances of works by the great Russian composers.
- The season also marks John Adam's 70th and Philip Glass's 80th birthdays
- Other treats include Bach's *The Well-Tempered Clavier* (Book I) performed by Andras Schiff.

Along with the UK's leading orchestras, renowned overseas visitors to the Proms this season include the Pittsburgh and Cincinnati Symphony orchestras, the Royal Concertgebouw Orchestra, Deutsche Kammerphilharmonie Bremen, the Chamber Orchestra of Europe, the Orchestra of La Scala Milan, Freiburg Baroque Orchestra, and the Oslo, Vienna and Royal Stockholm Philharmonic orchestras.

Valery Gergiev also conducts the Mariinsky Orchestra in a Russian programme, and Daniel Barenboim and his Staatskapelle Berlin perform Elgar's first two symphonies. Other eminent conductors include Sakari Oramo, Bernard Haitink, Riccardo Chailly, Louis Langrée and Manfred Honeck.

The 2017 season's exciting soloists include violinists Lisa Batiashvili, Isabelle Faust, Leonidas Kavakos, Anne-Sophie Mutter and Nicola Benedetti, violist Lawrence Power, pianists Andras Schiff, Leif Ove Andsnes, Emanuel Ax and Denis Matsuev, and soprano Renee Fleming, among others.

There are 22 Proms in the package. The duration of individual pieces varies between 75-115 minutes. The total duration of the package is 32 hours 50 minutes hours.
